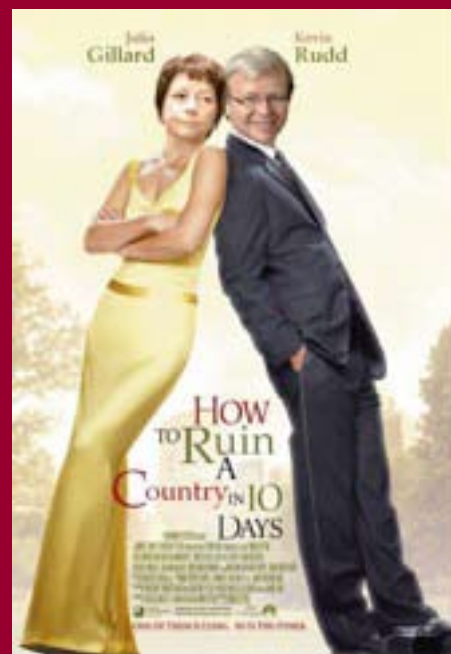

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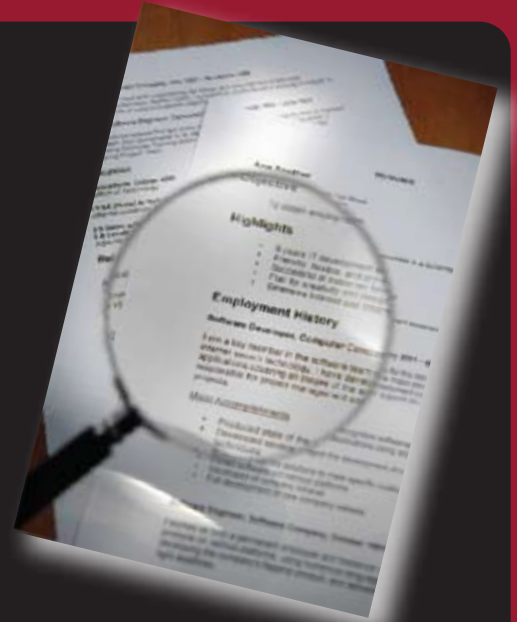
# CANDIDATE INFORMATION PAGE

As a Professional Recruitment Agency – we cannot **STRESS** hard enough to Candidates the importance of providing an accurate and up to date C.V.

Accuracy in maintaining commencement dates and end dates for jobs is imperative, not only the year, but the month as well. Spell check is not an accurate way of checking your document, proof reading is essential as is the layout of the C.V. itself – your C.V. must be appealing to the eye to read and have an “ease” about the information contained that can be easily digested by the reader.

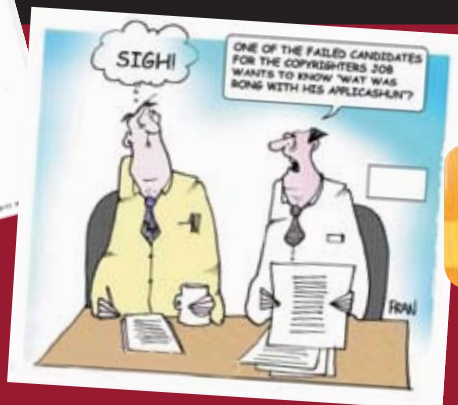
Remember, the person reading your C.V. has never met you before – therefore that old adage of “judging a book by it’s cover” is very real in this case!

An opening synopsis of your experience is a very good “eye catcher” as this immediately gives a snapshot of your career. Follow this with details on tertiary education, post graduate studies and any other information relative to study or courses. Start with your current job, not your first job and work your way back through your career history. Ensure that you name the company and the designation you were employed under (e.g. title of your job), with the month and year you commenced and the month and year you finished the position. Each position should be outlined in regards to your duties and responsibilities in a “bullet” form and some additional notes to explain the position further.



Finalise your C.V. with some personal details such as hobbies or interests and also three referees (it is **NOT** a good idea to include your current employer as a referee unless they are aware you are leaving or for some other reason), ensure that these references are up to date and their contact details relevant.
